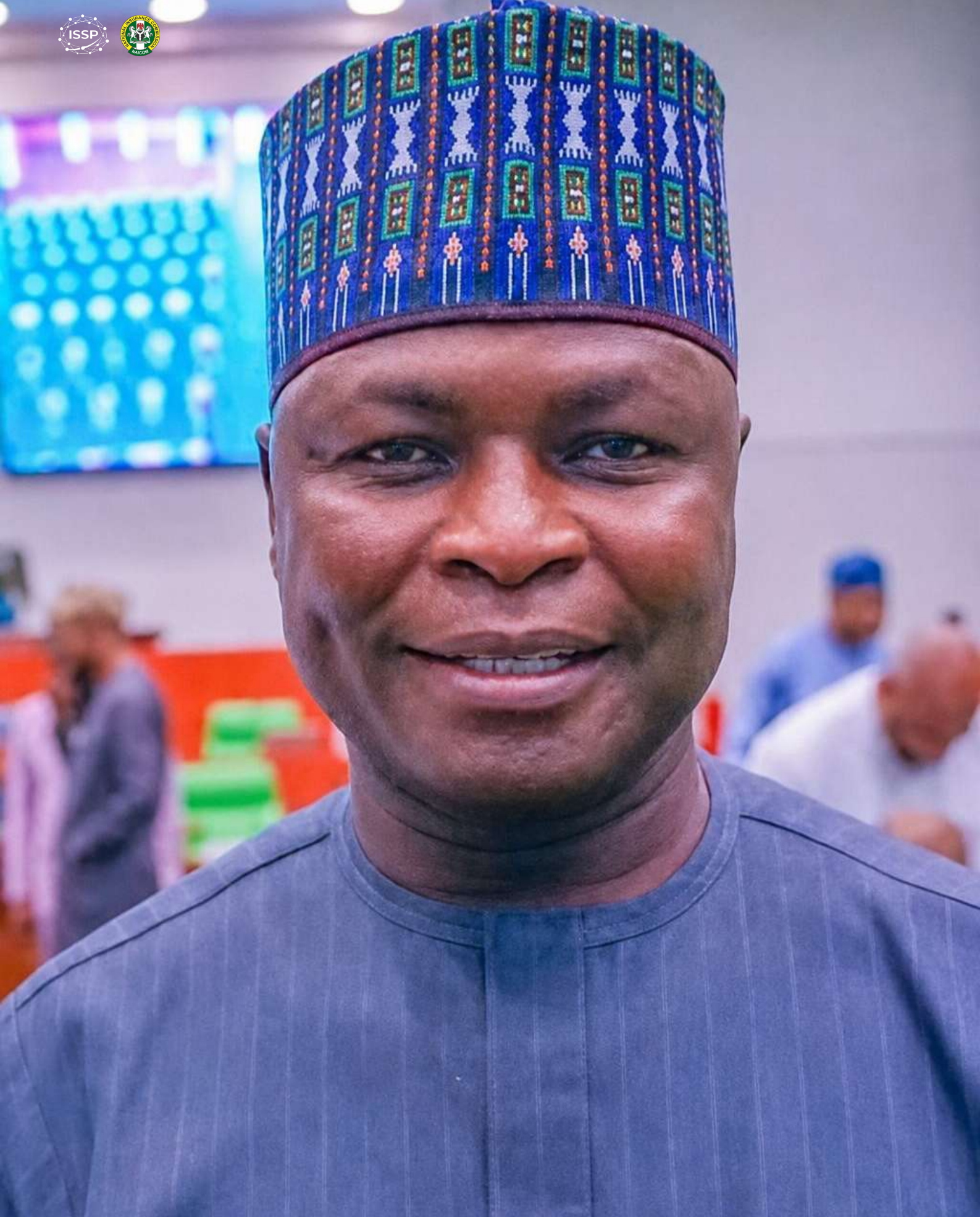

ABOUT THE INSURANCE SECTOR STRENGTHENING PROGRAM (ISSP)

The Insurance Sector Strengthening Program is a 36–60 month transformative initiative designed to strengthen Nigeria’s insurance industry through advocacy, awareness, capacity building and inclusive growth.

The programme seeks to raise insurance penetration from 0.5% to 10% of GDP by 2031, ensuring equitable access for women, youth and MSMEs.

PROGRAMME AT A GLANCE

<u>Duration</u>  36 - 60 months	<u>Target Beneficiaries</u>  5 Million+ Nigerians across all 36 States and FCT
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PRIMARY GOAL

- Raise the insurance-to-GDP ratio from 0.5% to 10% by 2031.
- The programme is designed to respond to Nigeria’s critically low insurance penetration and the structural barriers affecting sector growth.
- Despite Nigeria’s position as Africa’s largest economy, insurance penetration remains at 0.5% of GDP, compared with a continental average of 3.2%.
- The ISSP identifies key challenges including limited awareness, weak product innovation, gender disparities, youth exclusion, poor integration with the financial ecosystem and limited insurance coverage among MSMEs.
- The programme provides a coordinated vehicle for addressing these challenges through measurable interventions and multi-stakeholder action.
